The GingerEnsemble dedicates itself to experimental music with a kind of "historical informed performance practice" and places itself in the tradition of the "composer/performer" as exemplified e.g.by the legendary "Sonic Arts Union". But as not to lean too heavily on the "historical", however, exciting original non-hierarchical, process-orientated compositions and performances by the members of the ensemble will also be presented. By means of algorithmic composition, electro-acoustic music, and the experimental use of new media, aspects of perception will be investigated.

# **Guest Composer/Performer**

#### Miroslav Savić

born 1954 in Belgrade, belongs to that generation of artists of the former Yugoslavia who, through performances, action concerts and a radical passion for experimenting, caused an international sensation. Miroslav Savić studied composition and orchestration at the Belgrade Music Academy. Besides over one hundred works for classical orchestration, his oeuvre includes experimental performance, minimal music, electronic music, and interactive installations. He is Professor for Computer Music at the "Nova Akademija umetnosti" (New Art Academy) Belgrade.
